2023 CVEF GRANTS

CVEF has awarded over \$188,000 in grant funds to some 150 projects and events over the past 15 years. This year's eight grantees, along with the 2023 Howard Kelley Community Service Award recipient, were recognized for their achievements at a joint reception held on October 12.

➤ STEM Camp: DMYFS and DMLWC will run 8 individual programs and 2 week-long summer STEM camps for ages 7-13.



- ➤ Teen Book Boxes: Durham Public Library and CRHS, via a collaborative effort, will disseminate the DPL's individualized book box subscription program through CRHS.
- Community Recycling: CRHS' ECO Club will establish additional recycling collection stations, as well as expand recycling options and educate citizens.
- ➤ Brewster Communication Board: A Communication Board will be installed in the playground to enhance expressive skills for neurotypical and neurodiverse individuals.

 - ➤ Community Connections:

 Students involved in the MakerSpace project will collaborate
 with local businesses to design
 and create actual products that
 will be of use to them.
 - ➤ Community Center Atrium Garden Restoration: Durham Garden Club will renovate the garden with native pollinator plants and create a learning garden for the community.
